Anna	WATASHI NO HEYA WA KOCHIRA DESU. DÔZO.	Please.
さくら	すごい！これは全部マンガ？	Amazing! Are all these manga?
Sakura	SUGOI! KORE WA ZENBU MANGA?	
アンナ	それは私の宝物です。	They are my treasures.
Anna	私は毎日マンガを読みます。 SORE WA WATASHI NO TAKARAMONO DESU. WATASHI WA MAINICHI MANGA O YOMIMASU.	I read manga every day.



Grammar Tips

① MASU-form verbs Verbs : See pp.54, 55

- ◆ Verbs that end with MASU are called "MASU-form verbs."
The MASU-form verbs are used when speaking politely.
- ◆ To make it negative, we change MASU to MASEN.
e.g.) YOMIMASU (to read) ⇒ YOMIMASEN (not to read)

② [Subject] WA + [Object] O + Verb

- ◆ The typical word order in Japanese is "subject, object, and verb."
e.g.) WATASHI WA MANGA O YOMIMASU. (I read manga.)
- ◆ The particle O indicates the object of an action.
